

Oozing boilies for Bream

Most of my angling is targeted at fishing for specimens of some type or another. But when I get just half a day in a little gem of a water that I like to fish with the feeders for whatever comes along.

Reed lake on the Mid Kent Fisheries ticket is just 3 acres and is a beautiful little lake surrounded by overhanging trees, reeds, a couple of islands and of course the fishing can be great.

There are no monsters in this lake its just about having a bit of fun. I fish it with a couple of avon style rods and small method feeders. My mix for this mornings fishing was half a bag of Sonubaits Hemp n Hali crush with some softened 2mm fin perfect pellets added and for hookbaits I was trying the new Sonubaits Oozing boilies.

First bite of the day was one of the lakes rarely caught carp, its not a carp lake and they dont get caught very often, this one didn't get caught either as I lost her to a hook pull on the way in!! From then on it was the lakes Bream that moved in and I managed around 30lb of various sizes up to 5lb before I had to call it a day.



Im very impressed with the new Oozing boilies, they are just the right texture that they stay on the hair but are also nice and soft oozing attraction with a light cloud around the bait, I can see them getting used quite a bit in my specimen fishing.
